

Junior Membership

Applying for Membership

- Fill in your Nomination Form and ensure the form is signed by your parent or guardian.
- Upon lodging your Nomination Form with the Office - enclose your Nomination Fee (as soon as your nomination form and fee are received you are considered a honorary member and you may start utilising the facilities immediately.
- The Administration Staff will provide you with a hand written receipt – this receipt may be used as a form of membership identification if you wish to play golf prior to receiving your Membership Card.
- A letter requesting you to attend a New Juniors Meeting will be forwarded to you. Once you have attended this meeting your Nomination will be forwarded to the Committee for approval.
- Once the committee has accepted your Nomination, a letter advising of your acceptance and an invoice for your Subscription (Yearly Membership Fees) will be forwarded to you.
- Upon payment of your Membership Fees you will receive your Membership card in the mail.

Junior Membership – What does it entitle me to?

Junior Membership allows you to utilise the 18 Hole Championship Course, Par Three Nine Hole Course and all practice facilities.

This form of Membership is available to Boys and Girls between 12 and 17 years of age. Once a Junior attains the age of 18, he/she progresses to the intermediate category of membership.

Pee Wee Membership

Pee Wee Membership is available to boys and girls under the age of 12.

This category of Membership allows you to utilise the Par Three 9 Hole Course and all practice facilities.

Once a Pee Wee Member attains the age of 12, he/she progresses to the junior category of membership.

Pee Members must have Management's permission to play on the Main Course.

If you do not have a current handicap you must play the Par 3 Course until you have reached a certain standard.

Juniors wishing to obtain a handicap for the main course can do so by handing in 5 cards under 120 strokes of which at least 3 must be played at Pacific. These cards must be signed by a person with an official Australian Golf Union (AGU) or Women's Golf Australian (WGA) handicap.

When you play for a handicap you can do so mid-week or on a Sunday (Sunday's in the competition field – you are also asked to place Junior (JNR) and for handicap (HAN) beside your name).

Competition Time Sheets

Saturday

Main Course

Once you have obtained a handicap you may participate in the Saturday Junior Field competition held on the main course. This timesheet is available 1 week prior to the competition. (It is important that you write (JNR) next to your name on the time sheet.

You are required to report to the pro shop 15 minutes prior to your hit-off time for all main course competitions.

Par Three 9 Hole Course

The Par Three Course competition hits off from 8:00 am every Saturday morning on the Par Three course – no need to book - just report to the 1st Tee of the Par Three Course and you will be organised into groups.

Sunday

Main Course

As previously mentioned, the Sunday competition may be played to obtain your handicap, the time sheet is available at the office two weeks prior to the competition.

There are mid week competitions also available, Juniors with handicaps may play in these events during the school holidays.

Competition Fees

Competition fees are applicable in all competitions. They must be paid to the pro-shop 15 minutes prior to your tee off time.

PLAYING RULES FOR JUNIOR MEMBERS UNDER 12 YEARS OF AGE

ALL JUNIOR MEMBERS UNDER 12 YEARS OF AGE ARE ONLY PERMITTED TO PLAY THE PAR 3 COURSE UNLESS:

- 1. THE JUNIOR PLAYER IS CERTIFIED BY THE CLUB PROFESSIONAL, GOLF MANAGER OR CLUB CAPTAIN THAT HE OR SHE HAS ATTAINED A SATISFACTORY STANDARD TO PLAY THE 18 HOLE COURSE *AFTER ATTAINING CERTIFICATION THE JUNIOR MEMBER CAN ONLY PLAY ON THE 18 HOLE COURSE ON NON COMPETITION DAYS***
- 2. UNDER 12 JUNIOR MEMBERS MAY PARTICIPATE IN THE *INTRODUCTION TO 18 HOLE COURSE COMPETITION* TO ATTAIN CERTIFICATION WHICH COMMENCES 7TH FEBRUARY 2004 WITH FIRST 9 HOLES ON PAR 3 COURSE AND LAST 9 HOLES ON THE 18 HOLE COURSE (COMMENCING FROM 10TH TEE)**
- 3. CERTIFIED UNDER 12 JUNIOR MEMBERS WHO CAN DEMONSTRATE THEY HAVE A PLAYABLE KNOWLEDGE OF THE RULES OF GOLF AND GOLF ETIQUETTE, MAY PARTICIPATE IN COMPETITION PLAY PROVIDED:**
 - **NO FULL MEMBER IS DEPRIVED OF A POSITION TO PLAY**
 - **THE JUNIOR MUST HAVE AN AGU HANDICAP**
 - **THE JUNIOR MUST PLAY WITH A FULL MEMBER**

and

 - **UNTIL THE JUNIOR CAN DEMONSTRATE THAT HE DOES NOT CONTRIBUTE TO SLOW PLAY, MUST PLAY AT THE END OF THE FIELD**
