CLUB CHAMPIONSHIPS

ALL GRADES

First Round – Saturday 10th September 2011

Second Round - Sunday 11th September 2011

The top 12 players, in each grade, (plus ties) will qualify to play in the third and fourth rounds

Third Round – Saturday 17th September 2011

Fourth Round – Sunday 18th September 2011

MATCH PLAY CHAMPIONSHIPS

There will be Two Stroke qualifying rounds played on Saturday 5th & Saturday 12th February 2011. The leading eight players in each grade will be invited to play in the Match Play Championships. They will be played on the following days:

QUARTER FINALS

Sunday 27th February 2011 (18 Holes)

SEMI FINALS

Sunday 6th March 2011 (18 holes)

FINAL

Sunday 13th March 2011 (36 Holes)

FOURSOME CHAMPIONSHIPS

Members Foursome Championships (36Holes)

Sunday 31st July 2011

Mixed Foursome Championships (27 Holes)

Sunday 21st August 2011

JUNIOR CHAMPIONSHIPS

Juniors are eligible to participate in the Club Championships. Juniors are also eligible to compete in the Match Play Championships.

MEMBER'S GUESTS

Members are encouraged to bring visitors to the Club, for both golf and social occasions. Members are responsible for the behaviour and dress of their guests at all times. Members can bring guests for most Sunday, Wednesday and Friday competition events, with limited invitation events held on Saturdays throughout December and January.

RECIPROCAL MEMBERS

Such members are restricted to six games in any one year unless permission for additional games is obtained from the Golf Manager. Reciprocal members must show a current membership card from their home Club. Golfink handicapping cards are NOT acceptable as proof of membership.

MEMBER'S DRESS

Players must be properly dressed at all times, conforming to the standard as stipulated on display. Members are to ensure that their guests conform to these requirements.

MEMBER'S PROPERTY

Members are responsible for the safety of their property left on the Course or in the Clubhouse. Clubs may NOT be left in the club house.

Lockers are available for storage of personal belongings and can be purchased on enquiry from the office.

STORM SIREN/AIR HORN

1. When play is suspended by the Golf Manager for a dangerous situation e.g. lightning, if the players in a match or group are between the play of two holes, they must not resume play until the Golf Manager has ordered a resumption of play.
2. If they are in the process, of playing a hole, they **MUST** discontinue play immediately and not resume play until the Golf Manager has ordered a resumption of play. If a player fails to discontinue play immediately, he/she is disqualified unless circumstances warrant waiving the penalty as provided in Rule 33/7
3. In the case of the course becoming unplayable, players in a match or group, if they have started play of a hole, they may discontinue play immediately or continue play of the hole. In any case play must be discontinued after the hole is completed.

4. The following signals will be used:-

(a) One prolonged note of the siren – discontinue of play immediately.

(b) The Golf Manager will notify the players when it's safe to return to the course & One prolonged note of the siren will sound to resume play.

Note: The Storm siren/air horn will be sounded only when Club Competitions are in progress.

BEHAVIOUR IN THE CLUBHOUSE

No Member or Visitor shall behave in a manner prejudicial to the welfare to the Club.

COMPLAINTS

All complaints shall be made in writing to the General Manager of the Club.

ETIQUETTE

Obtain a copy of the booklet (available from the Golf Manager's Office) which contains handy information on Etiquette, Dress Standards, Motorised buggy rules and also includes some tips that will help to speed up play.

SOCIAL PLAY

All members wishing to play a social round are to book their round via the Golf Office or the internet. All social play times are run by a timesheet to reduce waiting time for all members. The social play timesheet is available 2 weeks prior. Group bookings can be made in advance of this time by booking directly with the Golf Manager.

MEMBERS INFORMATION NIGHTS

Every new member should attend an "Introductory" or "New Members night." Arrangements can be made at the Golf Office to be included in the next available session. A wealth of information can be obtained by your attendance to enable you to enjoy the full facilities of your club.

MOTOR BUGGIES

The following rules are to apply:

- a. Not to be driven between the **Blue lines and the greens** or in the absence of these lines within a perimeter of five metres of greens, and two metres of bunkers or tees.
- b. To be driven slowly and negotiate slopes carefully.
- c. Avoid damage from overhanging trees.
- d. A maximum of two people on a buggy at a time.
- e. Persons under the age of 18 are not permitted to drive Motorised buggies/trikes on Club property.
- f. **90 Degree Rule (Posted on Motorised Carts)**
Buggies are to be driven on cart paths and rough where no paths are available. Drive onto the fairway once you have reached your ball. Carts should then move immediately back onto the nearest path or rough to travel to the next shot.

COMPETITION TIME SHEET REQUIREMENTS

Pacific Golf Club operates an electronic booking system.

Members have the option of either booking on the touch screen in the Clubhouse or via the internet through Pacific's web page. For further details please contact Reception or the Golf Manager. To make a booking for Saturday, the timesheet becomes available online from Monday nights at 6.00pm.

Saturday Time Sheet (General) :-

Saturday timesheets are constructed in such a way that every alternate group is either shaded or clear; distributing shaded and clear sections throughout the morning and afternoon fields.

Saturday timesheets are released 8 days prior to the event. (Friday 1 week prior) The sheet is released in two halves, one at 10.30am (shaded areas) and the other at 6.15pm (Clear areas). Entry for these sheets is from a ballot system.

The ballot sheet for the 10.30am release is available from 10am. Members are to write on the appropriate ballot sheet for the Morning or Afternoon field.

At 10.30am the Golf Manager or a representative will conduct a random draw for both the morning and afternoon field for the shaded areas only. Members will then be called in order from this ballot to enter their name onto the timesheet proper together with their membership number.

A member is entitled to enter a maximum of 4 names with their membership numbers on the time sheet. Members cannot use a proxy for the ballot, the member must be there in person to write on the timesheet .If a member enters his name on the time sheet proper he is not permitted to enter a name on the waiting list.

The same procedure as above is carried out with the evening ballot. However the ballot is for the clear sections of the timesheet, with the ballot sheet becoming available from 5.30pm with the ballot commencing at 6.15pm.

ALL CLUB COMPETITIONS

- Golf Australia Handicaps apply.
- Before visitors can receive any prize they must have registered 3 cards in competition play at their Home Club in the last 12 months.
- **Club Trophies and Run Down Balls are held at the Golf Manager's office for a maximum period of 3 months.**

All Club 4 ball events now permit members to use their full GA handicap ie: Men 36 & Ladies 45.

Scorecards for all events are to be placed in the scorecard box opposite the ramp entry immediately at the conclusion of play. Cards handed in after the last call may not be eligible for the competition of the day.

CONDITIONS OF PLAY - GENERAL

TIME OF STARTING (Rule 6-3a)

"If the player arrives at his starting point, ready to play, within five minutes after his starting time, in the absence of circumstances which warrant waiving the penalty of disqualification as provided in Rule 33-7, the penalty for failure to start on time is the loss of the first hole to be played in match play or two strokes in stroke play. Penalty for lateness beyond five minutes is disqualification".

The Starter/ Golf Manager/Captain will reserve the right to move any player to the end of the field or refuse a competition game should the player fail to register in the pro shop at least 10 minutes prior to their stipulated hit off time.

Mobile phones must be turned off or on silent mode whilst on the course

PACE OF PLAY POLICY

The Pace of Play shall be defined as the total time taken (including refreshment breaks, time spent looking for lost balls etc) from initial tee off to the clearing of the final hole of play (referred to as the completion of a round).

Effective 1st June 2006, the following PAP times will apply to all golf events at Pacific Golf Club. Please note that these are MAXIMUM allowable times.

- Single Stableford 4 hours 20 minutes
- Four-Ball Stableford 4 hours 20 minutes
- Four-Ball Stroke 4 hours 20 minutes
- Mixed Pairs 4 hours 30 minutes
- Single Stroke 4 hours 30 minutes

IDENTIFYING A SLOW GROUP OR PLAYER

A slow group or player is identified by being one clear fairway behind the group in front or by taking 20% or more time allocated to play a three hole bloc. Clearly, a group's position in the field is immediately behind the group in front, not in front of the group behind.

DEFINITION OF CLEAR FAIRWAY

On par fours and threes – when the group in front has cleared the putting green. On par fives – when the group in front has sufficiently cleared the fairway or the green allowing the following group to safely play their shots.

DEFINITION OF THREE HOLE BLOC

Defined as the PAP time allowance in minutes divided by six.

EXAMPLE: - For a Single Stroke event the PAP allowance is for 4 hours 30 minutes or 270 minutes in total. Divided by six it is 45 minutes. This calculation provides a reasonable time allowance to play three holes (one sixth of the total 18 holes).

PENALTY FOR SLOW PLAY

If a player receives three warnings for slow play within a three month period they will be suspended from play at Pacific Golf Club for a period of one month. Penalties (if applied) will always apply to the group and not an individual player.

APPLICATION OF PENALTY

If a group is observed to be falling behind, they will receive a Pace of Play warning and the Marshal will note their names and the position on the course. The group will be given two holes to catch up to the players in front.

If no improvement has been made after two holes, the group will receive an "Official Warning for Slow Play" by the Course Marshal. Their names will be noted as will their position on the course and the time the warning was issued. The Course Marshal will also stamp the players score cards with a "WARNING" stamp and advise the group that they have a further two holes to improve their position in the field.

If the group makes no endeavour to improve their position in the field the Course Marshal has the authority to issue a second "Official Warning for Slow Play". The Course Marshal will again note the names, the course position and the time the second warning was issued. Score cards will again be stamped "WARNING".

In the instance where a second "Official Warning" has been issued on the same day, the Course Marshal shall immediately communicate the warning to the Golf Manager via two way radio or mobile telephone.

A third "Official Warning" will result in the offending group being asked to leave the golf course immediately by the Golf Manager or the Captain.

ABUSIVE LANGUAGE OR INSULTING BEHAVIOUR BY A PLAYER TOWARDS A MARSHAL

Any report of abuse, insult or intimidation to the Course Marshal will result in the offending player/s being formally requested to attend a meeting with the Match Committee to explain their actions. In extreme cases, a member/associate or junior can have their membership terminated. In such cases, the Board shall exercise such powers in accordance with the Rules and By-Laws of Pacific Golf Club Inc.

WHO CAN APPLY PENALTIES

The following people have the authority to apply penalties:-

- The Course Marshal
- The Club Captain
- The Golf Manager
- The Match Committee
- The Board

APPEALING PENALTIES

Any member has the right to appeal the penalty issued by contacting the Club Captain within twenty-four hours of the penalty being issued. The Captain will review the facts and a decision will be made. Please note that being the fastest player in a known slow group is no defence. The Captains decision will be final.

REPEAT OFFENDERS

Repeat offenders are deemed to be those players who have received more than six "Official Warnings for Slow Play" in one calendar year. The Club Captain shall exercise formal sanctions such as suspension or limitation of playing rights for repeat offenders after having observed due process and after having gained Board approval to take such action. In such cases the Board shall exercise such powers in accordance with the Rules and By-Laws of Pacific Golf Club Inc.

THE HALFWAY HOUSE

In all instances, the break between the first and second nine is incorporated in the total PAP time. The break is not a “given”. It must be earned by playing the first nine holes within the PAP timelines. If players do not play their first nine holes within the PAP timelines, they should proceed directly to their next tee in preparation for tee off.

CALL UP

The 5th, 9th, 10th, 15th and 18th holes are Compulsory Call Up holes. On all par 3 holes, the common sense rule applies. If the next tee is occupied, call up the players following. If the next tee is free, putt out and move on.

CALLING THROUGH

Players are reminded of the etiquette associated with looking for lost balls in the rough or in a hazard (creeks/ creek banks). If a ball is lost in general play and it is obvious that it is going to take some time to find, the following players should be called through. Players are reminded that they have 5 minutes to find a lost ball before it has to be replayed or abandoned.

PLAYERS LATE TO THE TEE

Late to the Tee shall be deemed to be anyone who is not ready to hit off at their scheduled tee time. If a player is not present at the designated tee time and the fairway is clear the remaining players MUST hit off, unless the stand-by group is ready and agrees to move up. If all players present have teed off and departed the tee, the late player must join the group without teeing off from the first tee. In an individual stroke event the said player will be disqualified and may only play socially and act as a marker. In a four-ball or teams event the late arrival may only commence play from the next full hole the group will play. It is suggested that players re-read page 8 of the Fixture Book which clearly states that “All players must have registered with the Pro Shop at least 10 minutes prior to their stipulated hit off time”.

NEW MEMBERS/LADY MEMBERS/JUNIOR & SENIOR MEMBERS/SOCIAL PLAYERS/HIGH HANDICAPPERS

These players are treated exactly the same as any other member playing the golf course. All players will abide by the Pace of Play Policies during competition.

POLICY REVIEW

The PAP Policy will be reviewed by the Captain, the Golf Manager and the Match Committee. These reviews will be conducted every six months until the Policy is refined to the extent that competition play beyond four hours thirty minutes becomes a thing of the past.

PACIFIC WEDNESDAY CLUB

The Pacific Wednesday Club is a subsidiary Club within Pacific Golf Club. The Wednesday Club holds 18 Hole events each Wednesday. These competitions are open to every club Member and visitors.

Membership of the Wednesday Club is restricted to financial Pacific Golf Club members only and is available for an annual fee. See Wednesday Club website for details – www.pacificwedclub.com Members of the Wednesday Club receive a discounted competition fee, subsidised trip to Surfers Paradise during October, and an invite to the Wednesday club Christmas party, as well as many other benefits. Trophies for these Wednesday events are to be collected from the Wednesday Club organisers each Wednesday.

FOUR-BALL MATCH PLAY QUALIFYING ROUNDS

In 4 ball qualifying rounds, either in mixed or members, a player who enters more than one card and, before the game commences, and does not specify which card is to count for qualifying purposes, is deemed to accept the player nominated on the time sheet as his partner. Players not wishing to qualify for any match play events are to mark NTQ at the top of their card.

FOURSOME EVENTS

The handicap allowance is one half of the combined handicaps. Play is alternate from the tee. Player hitting off 1st Tee in the morning round is to hit off 10th Tee in the afternoon round. In the Mixed Championships, Members will hit off from the 1st Tee in the morning round.

The Members Foursome event for 2011 will contain both Junior (18 and under), Open and Senior (50+) events. Trophies for Nett scores Am and Pm as well as gross trophies are available for both the Members Foursome and the Mixed Foursome events.

HANDICAP REDUCTION AND REVIEW

Pacific Golf Club handicapping generally conforms to the Golf Australia Handicapping system as stipulated by the Golf Australia.

To obtain a current GA handicap, players must hand in 3 single stroke cards from Pacific Golf Club, all to be marked by a Member of a GA affiliated club.

In order to maintain pace of play and to ensure an enjoyable game, members will not receive a GA handicap until 3 successive stroke cards under 120 strokes are completed.

Competition cards that are disqualified may be used for handicapping purposes at the discretion of the Golf Manager.

MONTHLY MEDAL

This event will be conducted in four divisions each month viz January till October 2011. In the event of a tie on any day the winner of the Club Trophy will be decided by firstly applying exact handicaps, and if still tied, by count back. Ties will receive a Monthly Medal and be eligible to play in the Monthly Medal Final, to be played on Saturday 26th November 2011. Please Note: There will be no Monthly Medal for Nov & Dec. Best gross in the monthly medal will be awarded a prize and players are eligible to win both nett and gross trophies on the monthly medal.

THE DAM CUP

A cup donated by Kevyn Allen will be presented to the Best Nett Score on Monthly Medal Days. The Winner who will hold the "Dam Cup" until the next Monthly Medal Event, except November's winner, who will hold the Dam Cup up to and including Friday 16th of December 2011. During the period of time a Member holds the cup he may ask any Member to fill it - but only once, otherwise the Dam Cup is forfeited.

A.L.M.S. EVENT

This event has been instigated by the Active Life Members of Pacific Golf Club, and trophies for the day have been donated by these Members, namely:-

Tom Hogan, Laurie Valentine. Ray Brady, Paul Hinds, Peter Stone, Albert Zanco & Tom Molloy.

The event will be known as the "Active Life Members Stableford: (A.L.M.S.)".

MATCH PLAY EVENTS

The Committee has decided on Conditions of Play for all Match Play-Off Events, which are W. McK Robertson Memorial Trophy, President's Trophy, Patron's Trophy, Pacific Anniversary Four-ball. The top "4" qualifiers will play handicap match play & a draw will be posted on the board outside the Golf Managers Office.

Qualifying rounds for these match play events are held at various times during the year. Players not wishing to qualify for the match play rounds are to mark NTQ at the top of their card during the qualifying round.

1. Games may be played prior to the allocated day should both parties agree.
2. Handicaps in force at the commencement of the event shall apply throughout the competition.
3. Before starting the match the players should ascertain each others handicap.
4. Handicap strokes should be applied as follows:- The difference in the competitors handicaps should be determined and applied to the Match play index. The player with the lowest handicap gives the other players strokes in accordance the difference in handicaps previously determined, with the lowest marker playing off an effective handicap of scratch.
5. If the match is all square after 18 holes it will be played off hole by hole until one side wins a hole. The play-off, an extension of the stipulated round, will start where the match began and players must proceed directly from the last hole of the match to the first play-off hole.

6. The teeing ground will be identified by tee markers of the qualifying competition (NB: BLUE MARKERS) and competitors are permitted to start their rounds on either the 1st or the 10th tee as indicated on the starting sheet.

HANDICAPS FOR SATURDAY COMPETITIONS

1st DIVISION	UP TO 12
2nd DIVISION	13 TO 17
3rd DIVISION	18 TO 24
4th DIVISION	25 TO 36

The amount of divisions played for any other single event is determined by the overall number of entries.

CONDITIONS OF PLAY FOR P.G.A. MEMBERS

(Playing in Club Competitions)

1. Players must first report to the Club Professional.
2. Players are eligible to win Best Nett Competitions
3. Players must play on a handicap equal to that of the player with the lowest registered club handicap.
4. Players are ineligible to win the following:-
 - (a) N.T.P. competitions.
 - (b) Longest Drive competitions.
 - (c) Best Gross competitions.

NB- These conditions do not apply to the club professionals.

CLUB CHAMPIONSHIPS GENERAL

1. It is the responsibility of all players to familiarise themselves with these conditions.
2. Only FULL MEMBERS' with current GA handicaps are eligible for gross/nett event competitions.
3. Handicaps in force at the start of 36 and 72 hole events shall apply throughout that competition.

NOMINATIONS

1. All fees due for entry into the Club Championships (all classes) are to be paid before commencement of play in the first qualifying round. Payment made to the Golf Manager.
2. It is the player's responsibility to enter his name on the time sheet for the qualifying rounds of the Club Championship. Reserved times for the 3rd and 4th round will be allocated both in the morning and afternoon fields by the Golf Manager.
3. It is the responsibility of the player to nominate for the Senior, Veteran or Junior Championships.

RULES OF PLAY

1. The Club Championships, in each of four grades, are to be played over 72 holes of stroke play.
2. The Teeing Ground will be identified by blue tee markers and competitors are permitted to start their rounds at either the 1st or the 10th tee as indicated on the starting sheet.
3. The scores of the top 12 players (plus ties) in each grade after the first 36 holes will entitle those players to qualify to play in the third and fourth rounds.

4. The winner of the Club Championship will be the member with the lowest gross score after 72 holes.
5. The winners of the Grade Championships will be those members with the lowest gross score in their handicap group after 72 holes.
6. Best Nett competitions in each grade will be conducted over the first 36 holes of the Club Championships.
7. The winner of the Best Nett competitions will be those members with the lowest nett score in their handicap group.
8. All members entering the Club Championships are eligible for the Best Nett competition.

SENIOR/VETERAN CHAMPIONSHIPS

These competitions will be conducted in each grade between members who have had their 50th Birthday (Seniors) and 61st Birthday (Veterans) before the start of the Championships. Note: Seniors will be played in each grade, Veterans will be played in two grades 0-13, 14-36.

There is an additional cost for the entry into these events. The winner in each grade will be that player with the lowest gross score in his handicap group after 36 holes. Trophies will also be awarded for the best Gross and Nett scores.

HANDICAPS FOR CLUB CHAMPIONSHIPS

“A” GRADE - UP TO 5

“A 1” GRADE – 6 TO 9

“B” GRADE - 10 TO 13

“C” GRADE - 14 TO 18

“D” GRADE - 19 TO 36

SETTLEMENT OF TIES

1. In the event of a tie in Stroke play Honour Board Events, players must play a **sudden death play-off**. Honour Board events are Club Championships, Members' Foursomes Championship & the Mixed Foursome Championship.
2. In the event of a tie in scratch stroke play competition after 36 holes (36 hole event) players must play **sudden death play-off**.
3. In the event of a tie in a handicap competition 18 hole event, exact handicaps will be applied. The best score over the last 9 holes shall be used, if still tied the best nett score over the last 6 holes, or if still tied then the last 3 holes. If a tie still exists then hole by hole from the eighteenth.
4. In the event of a tie in 27, 36, 54 and 72 handicap stroke play events, exact handicaps will be applied, and if a tie still exists the best nett score over the last 18 holes shall be used and if still tied count-back as in (3) above.
5. In all cases the last holes are as per the score card, viz 10th to 18th.
6. In 18 or 36 hole match play competitions if a match is "all square" after 18 or 36 holes it will be played off hole by hole until one side wins a hole. The play-off, an extension of the stipulated round, will start where the match began and players must proceed directly from the last hole of the match to the first play-off hole.

JUNIOR MEMBERS

There are 3 categories of Junior Membership:

- Pee Wee Members are aged from 10 to 12 years and are only eligible to play on the Par 3 course.
- Par 3 juniors are aged from 12 to 18 years and are only eligible to play on the Par 3 course.
- Main Course Juniors are those Members who have achieved a certain degree of proficiency on the Par 3 Course as certified by our Golf Professionals and have obtained an GA handicap.

SATURDAY TIME SHEET REQUIREMENTS **(JUNIORS)**

1. Juniors Saturday timesheets are in the Golf Managers office, juniors are only eligible to be on the timesheet once.
2. Juniors may play in any vacancies in the Morning Field by arriving at the Club, provided there are no Members waiting for a game and the Golf Managers approval has been obtained. No junior Members are eligible to play in the afternoon field.

SUNDAY JUNIOR COMPETITION

Pacific Golf Club is facilitating a junior intermediate competition on Sunday mornings. There will be 8 spots available at 7.54am & 8.00am on the 10th tee.

A total of 8 playing spots. This competition is open to all Pacific Junior players with preference for intermediate level players and juniors with GA handicaps who were unable to get a game in the Saturday competition.

There will be strict criteria for players who do not have a GA handicap and players under 12 years of age.

1. Any player under 12 years of age must be accompanied by a parent or an adult until the child has a GA handicap and has shown proficiency in course management (being able to complete the round of golf in allowable time & keeping up with players in the group in front).
2. Be mindful of golf etiquette at all times.

3. The Golf Manager will determine who will be eligible to play unsupervised once a junior has attained their GA handicap.
4. Any player under 12 years of age who puts their name down to play and does not have a parent or adult with them will not be allowed to play on that day in that competition (with the exception a child under 12 years that has an GA handicap and sanctioned by the Golf Manager.)
5. All players wanting to play must put their name own on the list situated in the Golf Manager's office and on the Friday before the day of play the Golf Manager will allocate tee times to the players. It is up to the player to check their tee time on Friday or Saturday with the Golf Manager.

Handicaps

To retain a GA Handicap a player must submit three cards per annum between January 1st and December 31st each year.

All match play events are to be played using the MATCH index.

HANDICAPS

Each player is personally responsible for ensuring that the handicap on her scorecard is correct. **A card showing no handicap will be disqualified from a Nett event but the Gross score will stand.**

Immediately a handicap of .5 is reached the handicap goes up to the next number. Reductions in handicap take effect immediately a reducing score is returned.

COMPETITIONS

Fees are to be paid and/or name entered in Computer before play is commenced.

All Players are required to report to the Starter at least **20 minutes before starting time.**

All cards, signed, countersigned and showing the player's handicap must be placed in the scorecard box as soon as a round is completed.

A minimum of 6 players in each division is required to complete the round to form a competition. Sixteen players are required for a four-ball competition.

- B. Time sheet would not be used and starter would send groups off as they arrive.

DELAYING STARTING TIME

If a player decides not to play at her set time because of unsettled weather, she is not eligible to play in the day's Competition. She may, however, play at the end of the field.
